### Indoor Recess Threshold CHANGE

We found an inconsistency in what temperatures we were using for our indoor recess weather plan. Some of our communications said 17 degrees and some said 18 degrees. After calling several other schools to find out what their thresholds were currently (temps were a range between 10-20 degrees), we met with one of our teams and then with our entire staff and concluded that we felt a safe threshold was 15 degrees or below to call an indoor recess. We will use Weatherbug and the "feels like" temperature. Of course, we always reserve the right to call indoor recess if the weather is not conducive to a safe outdoor experience. Thank you.


