#### **School Safety Week**

#### **Traffic and Safety Procedures**

- We are a technology free driving campus! Please refrain from using your cell phone while driving on campus.
- No right turns out of campus from 7:40-8:10am & 2:35-3:05pm.
- Kiss-n-go lanes:
  - Pull forward as far as possible to allow cars to enter behind you
  - No idling zone—please turn off your car engine while you are waiting for your child
  - ° Students enter and exit via the passenger side of the vehicle
  - ° Do not get out of your car as staff are on duty to assist your child
- If you need to walk your child to their entry location, park your vehicle in the south parking lot and then walk with your child across the guarded crosswalk.
- Accessible parking is in the west parking lot. You must have the appropriate ADA license plate or placard to park in an ADA space for any amount of time.
- Per PSD policy, no dogs allowed on campus from 7:35 AM-3:05 PM. If you choose to walk your furry friend to school, please wait for your child(ren) on the hill near the Zach rock or at the foot bridge south of campus.



#### **Zach Enrichment Fund (ZEF) Annual Contribution**

Welcome to the 2022-23 school year at Zach Elementary! We hope this letter finds you refreshed and prepared for the new school year. Please remember to give to The Zach Enrichment Fund while registering your child this year. The suggested amount per student is \$100.

Our school's success has been largely attributable to our family support and contribution to The Zach Enrichment Fund (ZEF).

Poudre School District focuses its funding on the demographic risk indicators of each school. With few demographic risk indicators, Zach receives a low per-student allotment of operating revenue from the school district. The Zach Enrichment Fund (ZEF) supplements district and state funds by raising classroom budgets and supporting grants for teachers throughout the year.

#### **ZEF** funds have provided the following and more:

Kindergarten: Reading Eggs & Math Seeds curricula, math manipulatives, and Core project materials

First Grade: Science materials, including clay for layers of the earth project, math games and enrichments, and class library books

Second Grade: Laptops, book sets for reading groups, and bookshelves

Third Grade: Science materials, including magnets for experiments, math manipulatives, and novels for reading differentiation

Fourth Grade: Middle Ages Fair (fourth grade capstone experience), flexible seating, and books

Fifth Grade: Science curriculum supplies, core novels and, EnVision math books for additional challenges

Support your school community by making a \$100 annual contribution per student. To finish your child's enrollment, simply add "Annual Contribution - Zach Enrichment Fund" to your School Pay (psdschools.schoolpay.com) cart. Any contribution size is encouraged or you may drop off a check to the front office.

Funds received prior to the first day of school are especially crucial because they allow ZEF to solve immediate classroom requirements at the beginning of the year. We ask that your gift be made no later than back-to-school night/school supply distribution.

# 2022-23 school year: Families must apply to receive free meals!

For the upcoming 2022-23 school year, students will no longer receive free meals unless they have been approved for the Free and Reduced Meals program. This is a change from last year (the 2021-22 school year) with free meals being offered to all PSD students. The program that helped make that possible (related to the pandemic) is ending. For the 2022-23 school year, families must apply and be approved for the Free and Reduced Meals program to receive benefits. Applications for the 2022-23 school year are now being accepted

#### Paying for Meals

- Students may bring money to school and pay during mealtimes. Checks should

# 2022-23 School Year School Notice to Families About a School Resource Officer (SRO) Being in Class

Dear parents/guardians,

Our School Resource Officer (SRO), Kate Garcia, as well as our former SRO's, periodically stop by Zach for an informal visit with our students. They like to come by to say hello to our students or have a short visit with them in the cafeteria, on the playground, or in the classroom.

Occasionally, at the request of our teachers, SRO Kate will read a book to students at a pre-scheduled time in the classroom and/or do a community lesson on safety.

- If you would like your child to attend the book reading or community lesson with SRO Kate, you do not need to do anything.
- If you do not want your student to attend the book reading or community lesson with SRO Kate, you may opt your student out of this class by sending an email to Stacey Towne at stowne@psdschools.org. If you choose to do so, your student will be given topic-related work to complete during the scheduled book reading time or community lesson.
- If you do not opt out, it will be assumed that your student may attend.



# **Experiencing COVID-like Symptoms?**

- \* El día 0 es cuando se presentan por primera vez los síntomas, o la fecha en que las personas asintomáticas hayan obtenido un resultado positivo en la prueba.

**Estudiantes:** Notifiquen a la oficina principal o a la enfermera de la escuela, que su hijo(a) está en aislamiento debido a presentar síntomas similares a los de la COVID-19, o por haber obtenido un resultado positivo en la prueba de detección.

**Personal:** Reporten casos positivos o probables al supervisor/CRT, el cual ingresará la información del caso en "Refer-a-Case".

Resultado negativo en la prueba\*\*

Presenten comprobante de haber obtenido un resultado negativo en la prueba de detección de la COVID-19, y sigan las recomendaciones del CDPHE en "¿Qué tan enfermo es demasiado enfermo?"

\*\* Si ustedes han estado expuestos a la COVID-19 en casa, en los 10 días anteriores, deben obtener un resultado negativo en la prueba de laboratorio (PCR o molecular), para descartar la infección por el virus que causa la COVID-19. Los resultados de las pruebas en casa no aplican.

#### **School Health Services Program**

Do school districts need Parental consent to receive *Health First Colorado* reimbursements?

- Yes. Special Education law requires your one time consent on file.
- Your student's case manager will provide the document for you to sign.
- Annually a Notification of Access to Benefits will be distributed to parents.

My child is not eligible for Health First Colorado. Do I still need to sign the consent?

Yes. Your consent will be on file should your student become *Health First Colorado* eligible.

#### **School Health Services Program, continued...**

#### What is the School Health Services Program?

- The School Health Services Program allows school districts to seek reimbursement from Health First Colorado
- Partial reimbursement for health and medical services
- Provided to Health First Colorado-eligible students with an Individual Education Plan (IEP), 504 Plan, or other plan of care.
- Districts are required to use funds for additional or enhanced health/ health related services for all students

# Why are schools requesting *Health First*Colorado reimbursement

- Federal special education laws require school districts to provide IEP health services to students
- Federal law allows school districts to seek reimbursement for health services provided to Health First Colorado eligible students with an IEP, 504 Plan, or other plan of care
- Funds are used to provide expanded health services to all students
- Expanded services can include vision/ hearing screenings, Health First Colorado/ Child Health Plan Plus, outreach to uninsured families, access to emergency medication/dental services for uninsured students

# Which IEP health services are reimbursable through Health First Colorado?

Health and health related services listed in the IEP, 504 Plan, or other plan of care:

- Occupational therapy
- Physical therapy
- Speech language therapy
- Orientation/mobility/vision services
- Psychological/counseling/ social work services
- Nursing services
- · Personal care services and
- Specialized transportation

#### How do schools use the money they receive from Health First Colorado

Colorado law requires reimbursement funds be used to provide enhanced health and health related services to all district students

Services can include: additional nursing support, medical supplies and equipment, mental health support for students and families and vouchers to provide access to vision/dental/mental health services to uninsured students.

Contact your school *Health First Colorado* Coordinator for details on how your district utilizes these funds.

### I am concerned about confidentiality.

Who can see my child's health information if I allow my school district to bill *Health First Colorado* for eligible IEP, 504 Plan, or other plan of care services provided to my child?

Two laws determine who can see student health information:

- Federal privacy laws state only school health service providers, your child's private doctor, district Health First Colorado billing agent will see your child's school health records.
- Colorado's Health First Colorado Agency will see your child's school health records

#### Will Health First Colorado services my child receives outside of school be affected?

No. IEP, 504 Plan, or other plan of care health services provided by the school and reimbursed to the district do not affect your child's lifetime Health First Colorado henefits.

Students can receive health services at school on the same day they receive services outside of school.

#### ¿Qué es el Programa de Salud Escolar de Health First Colorado?

- El programa permite que los distritos escolares busquen reembolsos de Health First Colorado.
- Reembolsos parciales por servicios de salud y médicos.
- Proporcionados a estudiantes elegibles para Health First Colorado con un Plan de Educación Individual (PEI), Plan 504, o otro plan de cuidados.
- Se requiere que los distritos usen estos fondos para proveer o mejorar servicios relacionados con la salud para todos los estudiantes.

#### ¿Por qué las escuelas estár solicitando reembolsos de Health First Colorado?

- Las leyes federales de educación especial requieren que los distritos escolares provean PEI incluyendo servicios de salud a los estudiantes.
- Las leyes federales permiten que los distritos escolares busquen reembolsos por los servicios de salud prestados a los estudiantes con PEI, Plan 504, o otro plan de cuidados elegibles para Health First Colorado.
- Los fondos se utilizan para proveer servicios de salud adicionales a todos los estudiantes
- Los servicios adicionales pueden incluir pruebas de visión/audición, el plan Health First Colorado/Child Health Plan Plus, apoyo

a familias sin seguro médico, acceso a servicios médicos dentales de emergencia a estudiantes sin seguro

#### ¿Qué servicios de salud del PEI son reembolsados por Health First Colorado?

Servicios de salud y relacionados incluidos en el PEI, Plan 504, o otro plan de cuidados:
