Tech Take Home Day (Attachments): Monday, October 17th

During our tech practice take home day, please make sure to have your children return their tech (computers and chargers) the next day on Tuesday, October 18. This day is intended to better prepare us for any days we may need to take our technology home to learn. We want to make sure all our students have access. See attached letter for more information.

Transportation/Traffic Survey

Great news! The city is writing a grant this month to better support our student and staff safety. There are two safety elements going into the grant that came from a traffic study done last year:

- The crosswalk at Cinquefoil will be enhanced by moving it to the east side of the intersection, a median refuge built (once Kechter Road is restriped), and a Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon (RRFB) assembly added. This crossing should be staffed with a crossing guard during peak hours.
- The intersection of Jupiter Drive (Zach access) at Kechter Road will be signalized with a full signal (the pedestrian signal would be removed). The Traffic Control Supervisor can then be eliminated, but a crossing guard would remain during peak hours. Turn restrictions (such as northbound right turning vehicles leaving the school) would remain in place during peak hours.

Dear PSD families,

We appreciate your partnership in PSD and the important role you have in your child's education. Given our combined efforts to educate children, we want to ensure that you and your child have access to the technology tools to support learning at home.

The purpose of this communication is two-part. First, to explain what would happen if we needed to provide learning at home due to unforeseen circumstances such as inclement weather and, second, to explain how your child can use a laptop at home for school-related purposes throughout the year.

Online learning due to an unexpected school closure

First, we want to be prepared in the event of a weather or emergency-related closure to provide online learning if the situation requires it. In the spirit of being prepared, we are sending home a laptop and charging cable with your child so that you and your child can become familiar with the device and the available tools you may need to access. We can also provide your family with a portable cellular internet hotspot, often called a "MiFi," to get you connected to the Internet if you don't currently have reliable home connectivity. Just let us know!

Your child will bring home a laptop on October 17th.

Any time our schools must shift to online learning due to unforeseen circumstances, we will be instituting a shortened online learning schedule. During these closures to in-person learning, we would follow an elementary district-wide schedule for online learning. Secondary schools will maintain their current school schedule.

K-5 Elementary School Remote Schedule – Emergency School Closure Days

All PSD teachers have a Learning Page which provides asynchronous (learning independently) materials as well as information about how to connect to synchronous (learning together at the same time) virtual meetings.

9:00 am - 11:00 am: Virtual meeting with the classroom teacher on MS Teams or Google Meets

11:00 am - 2:00 pm: Asynchronous Learning and office hours support available from staff

Laptop use at home

Second, students can bring a laptop home as needed at any point. Examples of this may include assisting in completing homework, accessing virtual tutoring, access to additional enrichment activities, for parents to complete PSD forms, or to use other parent tools, such as

ParentVUE. While in some families, this may be unnecessary, in others, we recognize that a laptop, paired with a portable MiFi hotspot, might be an essential tool that helps connect your student and family to the tools and services necessary to participate in school today. Please talk with your school or child's teacher if you would like to have a laptop go between home and school.

We invite you to engage in this opportunity to learn about the tools for remote learning as well as explore other ways your elementary student may benefit from ongoing, regular access to a PSD issued laptop at home.

Estimadas familias del PSD:

Agradecemos su colaboración con el Distrito Escolar Poudre (PSD, por sus siglas en inglés), y el importante papel que tienen en la educación de sus hijos. Dado nuestro esfuerzo conjunto para educar a los niños y jóvenes, queremos asegurarnos de que ustedes y sus hijos tengan acceso a las herramientas tecnológicas para apoyar el aprendizaje en el hogar.

El propósito de este comunicado consta de dos partes: la primera, para explicar lo que sucedería si tuviéramos que brindar aprendizaje en el hogar, debido a circunstancias imprevistas como el mal clima, y la segunda, con el propósito de indicar la manera en que su hijo(a) podría utilizar una computadora portátil en el hogar, para fines relacionados con la escuela, durante todo el año.

Aprendizaje en línea debido a un cierre inesperado de la escuela

Como primera medida, queremos estar preparados para ofrecer aprendizaje en línea, si la situación lo requiere, en caso de un cierre relacionado con el clima o con una emergencia. Teniendo esto en mente, enviaremos a casa con su hijo(a) una computadora portátil, junto con su cargador, para que usted y él o ella puedan familiarizarse con el aparato y con las herramientas disponibles a las que puedan tener que acceder. También podemos proporcionarles a las familias un punto de acceso móvil a Internet, que con frecuencia se conoce como "MiFi", con la finalidad de que se conecten a Internet, en caso de que en la actualidad no tengan una conectividad confiable en el hogar. ¡Pónganse en contacto con nosotros si necesitan un MiFi!

Su hijo(a) traerá a casa una computadora portátil entre el 17 de octubre.

Cada vez que nuestras escuelas tengan que pasar al aprendizaje a distancia, debido a circunstancias imprevistas, se establecerá un horario de aprendizaje en línea más corto. Durante estos cierres en que no podamos tener aprendizaje en persona, seguiremos un horario para el aprendizaje en línea para las escuelas primarias en todo el distrito. Las escuelas intermedias y de "high school" (preparatoria) mantendrán su horario escolar actual.

Horario del aprendizaje a distancia para las escuelas primarias (kínder a 5.º grado) – Días de cierre escolar debido a una emergencia

Todos los maestros del PSD tienen una Página de Aprendizaje ("Learning Page") que proporciona material asincrónico (aprender de forma independiente), así como información sobre cómo conectarse a reuniones virtuales sincrónicas (aprender juntos al mismo tiempo).

De 9:00 a. m. a 11:00 a. m.: Reunión virtual con el/la maestro(a) del salón de clase a través de MS Teams o Google Meets.

De 11:00 a. m. a 2:00 p. m.: Aprendizaje asincrónico, y horario del personal para brindar apoyo.

Uso de la computadora portátil en casa

En segundo lugar, los estudiantes pueden llevar una computadora portátil a casa en cualquier momento, según sea necesario. Ejemplos de esto podría ser el servir de ayuda para completar una tarea escolar, tener acceso a una tutoría virtual o a actividades de enriquecimiento adicionales, para que los padres de familia llenen formularios del PSD, o usen otras herramientas del distrito como ParentVUE. Aunque esto pueda ser algo innecesario para algunas familias, somos conscientes de que tener una computadora portátil y un punto de acceso móvil a Internet, o MiFi, puede ser una herramienta esencial de ayuda para estudiantes y sus familias, con el objetivo de conectarse a las herramientas y los servicios necesarios para participar en la escuela en la actualidad. Hablen con su escuela o con el/la maestro(a) de su hijo(a), si desean tener una computadora portátil que se lleve a casa y se regrese a la escuela.

Los invitamos a participar en esta oportunidad para familiarizarse con las herramientas para el aprendizaje a distancia, así como explorar otras maneras en que su estudiante de la primaria pudiera beneficiarse del acceso continuo y regular a una computadora portátil que el PSD les preste, para uso en casa.

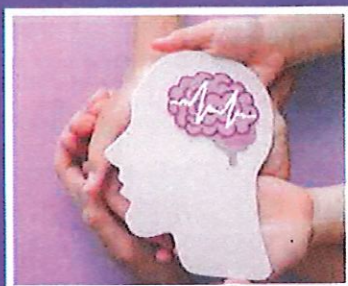


ADHD Family Education Series

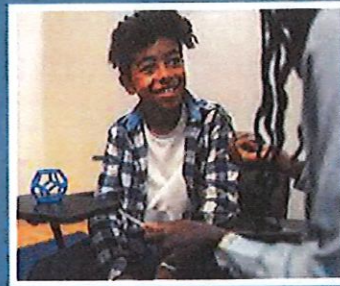
