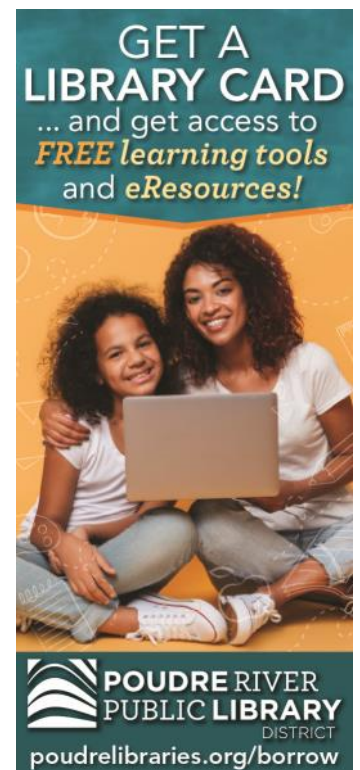

GRATITUDE

One of the best ways to cultivate positive emotions and resiliency is to practice gratitude. Practicing gratitude has been linked to strengthening relationships, increasing resilience, and lowering stress levels. Winter Testing

Acadience Assessments

December 5-15, the kinder, 1st, 2nd, and 3rd grade students (some 4th and 5th grade students may test depending on their needs) take the Acadience assessments. Acadience assessments help teachers identify children at risk for reading difficulties and determine the skills to target for instructional support. The benchmark assessments are given 3 times (fall, winter, and spring) over the course of the year, and if a child needs literacy intervention, Acadience assessments are used to progress monitor their skills every 2-3 weeks. MAP Assessments

Our winter MAP testing window will run from December 5 through January 27. District 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade students take MAP (Measures of Academic Progress) assessments in reading and math. These assessments are given 3 times per year (fall, winter, and spring). MAP assessments are computerized, adaptive tests (the difficulty of each question changes based on the previous answer) that measure growth and proficiency in the areas of reading and math. Both tests provide insights for teachers regarding a child's skill level in order to help them tailor their instruction. Results from both assessments are also used in the teacher evaluation process. 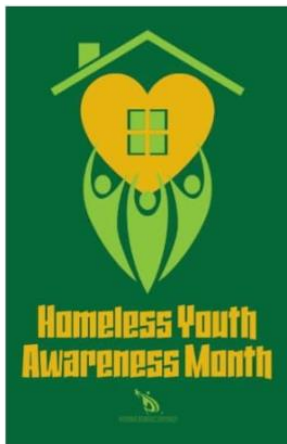
Join PSD's Efforts to Support Students Experiencing Homelessness.

During the 2021-2022 school year, Poudre School District identified **1,312 students** K-12, or over **4% of our student population**, who experienced some form of homelessness and qualified for McKinney-Vento services.

McKinney-Vento is a federal law and PSD program designed to provide students experiencing homelessness and housing insecurity with resources and protections. The main focus is to remove the educational barriers that those students face, placing an emphasis on immediate enrollment, attendance, and success. McKinney-Vento services are available to all PSD children and youth, from birth to 21 years of age, who lack a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence. What Can You Do to Help?

- **Raise Awareness** - November is National Homeless Youth Awareness Month, and National Hunger and Homelessness Awareness Week is Nov. 12-20 (<https://hhweek.org/>). Please share this information with your family, friends, neighbors, and colleagues, and take the initiative to learn more about youth homelessness and its challenges.
- **Wear Green** – Green is the official color of Homeless Youth Awareness Month. Our McKinney-Vento staff and site McKinney-Vento Contacts will be wearing green on Wednesdays throughout the month to help bring attention to issue of homeless children, youth, and families in our community. Please feel free to join us in this show of solidarity.
- **Donate** - PSD's McKinney-Vento program accepts monetary donations which are used to purchase things like gas cards, grocery cards, school supplies, undergarments/socks, clothing, coats, hygiene and household supplies, food, concurrent enrollment supplies, and much more. Our goal is to provide services that remove barriers and create a welcoming and safe school environment so that students can come to school, engage in learning, and succeed.

Inclement Weather Procedures

School closure, Delayed Start, and Early Release



Note: If all schools are open, information may not be sent to parents via email or posted on PSD's social media platforms. School status if schools are open, closed or on a delayed start is posted on the top right of the home page on the PSD website.

When bad weather rolls in, the PSD superintendent may decide to cancel school, start school later or close school earlier in the day. Please see below for details about each procedure.

If you're wondering how the decision is made, read [about the process here](#).

1. School closures:

Decisions about weather-related school closures are made by 5:30 a.m. Parents and staff will be notified by email, by phone, and information will be posted on the PSD website and social media - [Facebook](#), [Twitter](#) and [Instagram](#). Regional media outlets will be notified.

Closure days will likely be no-school days. However, there may be some instances where the district may decide to do a remote learning day (i.e. multi-day snowstorm preventing access to schools, natural disaster impacting a school or schools, etc.).

- When schools are closed, all school activities and athletics are cancelled. [AlphaBest](#) is closed also.
- High school students who attend classes at [Front Range Community College](#) or [Colorado State University](#) should check with the college to determine if classes are in session.

2. Delayed start - 1 or 2 hours later than normal:

Delayed start decisions are usually made by 5:30 a.m. Parents and staff will be notified by email, phone and information will be posted on the PSD website and social media - [Facebook](#), [Twitter](#) and [Instagram](#). Regional media outlets will also be notified.

- **Bus pick up times:** Buses will pick up students at bus stops 2 hours later than the regular schedule. Road conditions may increase travel time for buses and students may have a longer wait time at bus stops.
- **Drop off and arrival times:** Students who walk to school, are dropped off or who drive should arrive 2 hours later than regular arrival times. Please do not arrive earlier.
- **Kindergarten and Early Childhood programs:** Morning-only kindergarten and Early Childhood programs are cancelled during a delayed start schedule. Afternoon kindergarten and Early Childhood programs follow normal schedules. Full-day kindergarten and Early Childhood programs start 2 hours later than normal and release on time.
- **Before- and after-school childcare:** [AlphaBest](#) will open at the normal time for students who attend the program.
- **School dismissal times:** Schools will dismiss students at normal times. Bus drop-off times in neighborhoods and parent pick-up times at schools will also be on regular schedule.
- **Breakfast:** Breakfast will not be served.

3. Early release:

If the weather changes to adverse conditions during the school day, PSD may decide to release students early. Parents are urged to develop a plan for situations when their student may be released early.

- Parents will be notified by phone and email. In addition, information will be posted on the PSD website and social media - [Facebook](#), [Twitter](#) and [Instagram](#). Regional media outlets will also be notified.
- [AlphaBest](#) will not be available after school if students are released early.
- Athletics and extracurricular activities will likely be cancelled.
