Starting with the 2023-24 school year, the majority of PSD elementary schools will use a new elementary literacy curriculum. The new curriculum resource, adopted by the Board of Education on Tuesday, is called Imagine Learning EL Education K-5. It will be used in all of our elementary schools except for Core Knowledge schools and dual language immersion schools; these schools will have their own literacy curriculum to meet their unique needs.

- Bethke, O'Dea, Traut, and Zach will use Amplify CKLA Skills K-2
- Harris and Irish will continue to use McGraw-Hill Wonders and Maravillas as English/Spanish companion programs

Thanks to hundreds of hours of work by our Literacy Materials Review Team, elementary school leaders, Teaching and Learning team, parents/guardians and many others, this K-5 adoption will provide direction and improve literacy instruction and student learning across PSD for the next decade.

Imagine Learning EL Education K-5 is a nationally recognized, teacher-developed curriculum that offers hands-on, multi-sensory activities and high quality texts. - 1:30 to 3 p.m. at Rocky Mountain High School, 1300 W. Swallow Road, in Fort Collins QPR training is about three simple steps anyone can learn to help save a life from suicide. These sessions are made possible through a partnership between The Alliance for Suicide Prevention and Leadership Fort Collins, which is associated with the Fort Collins Area Chamber of Commerce.

Just as people trained in CPR and the Heimlich Maneuver help save thousands of lives each year, people trained in QPR learn how to recognize the warning signs of a suicide crisis and how to question, persuade, and refer someone to help.

A cohort of the 2022-2023 Leadership Fort Collins class (Cindy Crosby, Nick Armstrong, Travis Trottier, Andrea Coy, and Dr. Erika Michalski) recognized PSD's efforts to address mental health concerns among our youth and wanted to provide support. They partnered with the Alliance for Suicide Prevention of Larimer County to offer a collection of QPR trainings for parents and community members seeking practical tools they can use if they encounter someone in crisis.

PSD is thankful for its many community partners that work to support our students and staff.



Dear Zach Families:

I am happy to report that all of our water fixtures tested BELOW both state thresholds for lead content during recent, state-required water testing at Zach. This means that our school's drinking and food preparation water is safe and healthy to drink.

You may be wondering why our school was tested for lead. All licensed childcare centers, preschools, and elementary schools in Colorado are required to test their drinking water for lead before May 31 this year in accordance with Colorado House Bill 22-1358: Clean Water in Schools and Child Care Centers, which Gov. Polis signed into law last June.

The law requires schools to perform remediation measures if fixtures test positive for lead levels in drinking water above a legal threshold. The Environmental Protection Agency's action level for lead in drinking water is 15 parts per billion (ppb), but our state has adopted a stricter threshold of 5 ppb.

Again, none of our fixtures tested at these levels.

Safety is our top priority, and we are communicating with you in order to be as transparent as possible. As a district, we often communicate with families and staff when something unexpected or negative happens at school and wanted to be sure to celebrate good news around the health and safety of students. I hope you find this information comforting and informative.

Detailed sample results for all schools being tested this year are posted publicly. Anyone can view them at the following link: https://cdphe.colorado.gov/environment/lead-safety/test-and-fix-water-for-kids. Results may take up to 30 days to be posted on this web page.
