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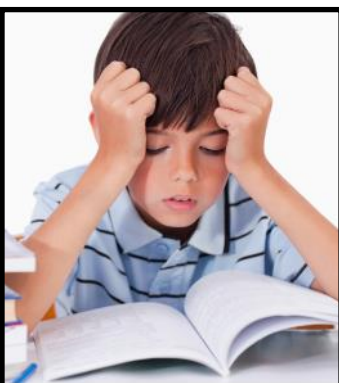

## End of the Year Medication Pickup

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Medications cannot be sent home with students at the end of the school year.

- Parents must pick up all medications on or before the last day of school. Medications must be picked up by the end of the school day. **REMINDER: the last day of school is a half day.**
- If medications need to be picked up before the last day of school, make arrangements with the school nurse or health tech.
- Emergency or as-needed medications (Epi-pens, Tylenol, Inhalers, etc.) must also be picked up.
- The school nurse will follow state health department procedures and remove all medications left in the health office to be disposed of properly by the DEA.
- If medications will be brought back to the school in the fall, you may obtain a medical permission form from the health tech in your school, or on the PSD website.

If you have any questions please contact your school nurse or health tech.

**This procedure is important to safeguard all students against improper or accidental ingestion of medication.**

## Tdap Vaccine Requirement 2023-2024 School Year

All 6<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> graders are required to have had a Tdap booster

- Most secondary students have had this booster, and it is recorded on their school record.
- Students entering 6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade may still need the vaccine.
- The "p" (pertussis) has been added to the standard Td booster in order to protect teens against whooping cough.

**Prior to the first day of school, a copy of the immunization record from the doctor's office must be provided to the school.**

- If they have already received the booster, you may give this record to their current school before school is out.
- vaccines are recommended for Hepatitis A, Influenza, Meningococcal disease, and Human papillomavirus (HPV), but are not required.

Colorado law ([Board of Health rule 6 CCR 1009-2](#)) requires all students attending Colorado schools and licensed child cares to be vaccinated against certain diseases, unless an exemption is filed.

### Exceptions:

Beginning in the 2021-2022 school year, the process of filing a nonmedical exemption changed. There are two ways to file a nonmedical exemption. **Be sure to check with your student's school or child care to find out if it needs a copy of the certificate of exemption.**

- File the certificate of nonmedical exemption WITH a signature from an immunizing provider OR
- File the certificate of nonmedical exemption received upon the completion of our online education module.

- Parents of students in grades K-12 claiming a nonmedical exemption must file one annually. **Nonmedical exemptions expire June 30 each year.** If you submit a nonmedical exemption on or before June 30, it will not be valid for the upcoming school year unless you signed the exemption during early registration.

### MINDFULNESS

Mindfulness is defined as the basic human ability to be fully present and aware of where we are and what we are doing, and in turn to avoid being overwhelmed by or reactive to our surroundings. For children, mindfulness can help to manage stress, build positive self esteem, and cultivate resilience. Mindfulness activities for kids also help to support the development of executive functions: paying attention and recalling information, shifting focus and moving from task to task when needed, and exercising self control. Research supports the benefits of mindfulness in improving our mental and physical health, as well as our relationships with ourselves and others. And, we have the tools to practice mindfulness with us all the time: our bodies and our thoughts!

#### Family mindfulness activity:

Take a mindfulness walk. While you walk around the neighborhood, along a trail, or on your way to school incorporate mindfulness by bringing your attention to the present moment and taking in your walk with each of your senses. Try the Spot the Rainbow or 5-4-3-2-1 activities while you walk.

Spot the rainbow grounding activity: Look around you and name 2-3 objects that are each color of the rainbow. If your thoughts begin to drift, bring your attention back to the activity.

Stop, Talk, Think, & Try

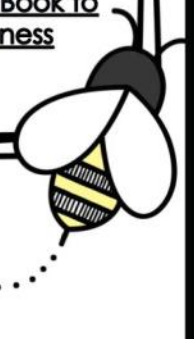
In the upper grades, we learned a STEP it up problem solving acronym.

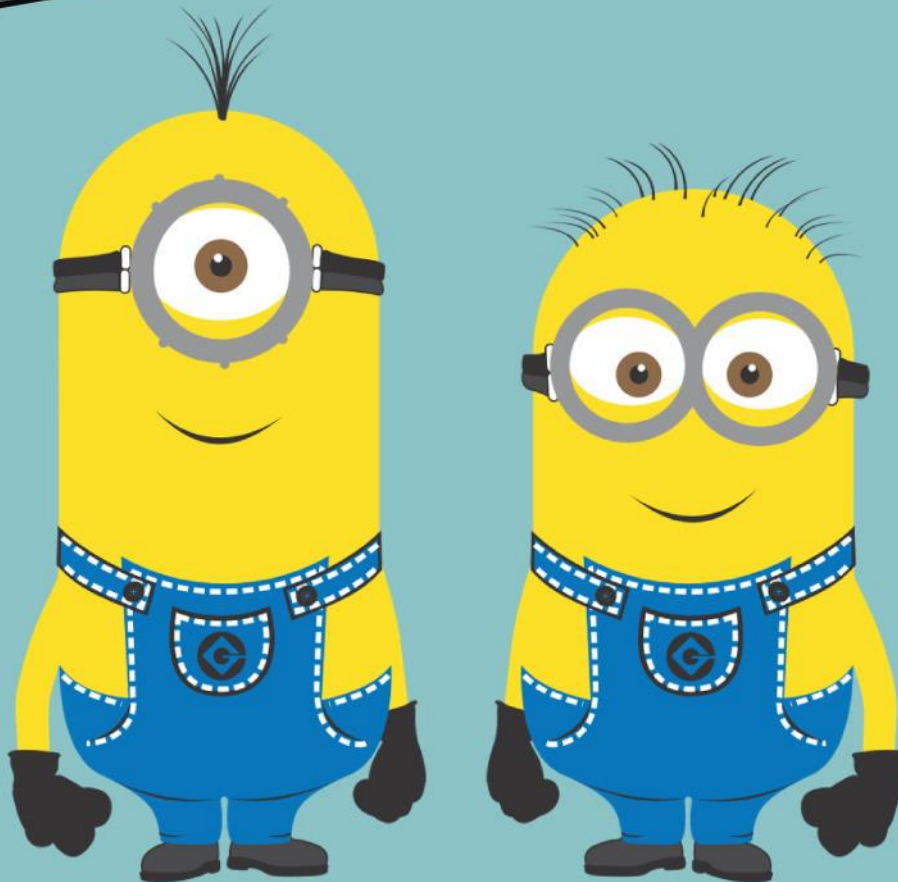
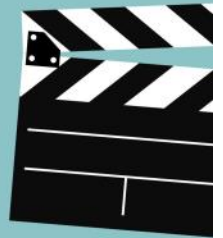
