PSD will offer sack meals to PSD students (beginning Aug. 24) from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m., Monday through Friday, at numerous PSD schools and additional locations (on scheduled school days).

Cost of meals:

- **Students buying meals** will be charged the normal breakfast and lunch prices. Because of COVID-19, the district will only accept online payments through SchoolPay accounts, but no convenience fee will be charged (typically \$1 per transaction).

Zach OnLine Academy (ZOLA)

Common Language: The term "virtual" refers to PSD Virtual School (PSDV), which is an entirely different school than Zach. It is for students registered for PSDV for the 20-21 school year and 100% of their learning is at home on the PSDV Curriculum.

Zach Online Academy (ZOLA) is for students registered to attend in-person at Zach Elementary. This group is in Phase 1 until October 14, and then may/may not return to in-person school depending on district decision.

All grade levels and Specials will be using the online platform of Google Meets for their Phase 1 instruction. FOR PHASE 1 ONLY:

Students need to attend online school from 8:15am-2:30pm Monday – Thursday, and 8:15-8:30am on Fridays. (Fourth grade will be 9:15-9:30am on Fridays).

Students have access to their homeroom instruction through their "Learning Page".

Click on the tab menu "Learning Pages", then choose the grade level, then the teacher.

COMMUNICATION

All families will receive direct communication from their homeroom teacher by end of day Friday, August 14.

ROSTERS

Class rosters are posted on our Zach website at https://zac.psdschools.org/

Along with our computer software, teachers of the previous grade level look at behavioral/social/academic needs of our students, and learning phases impacts to place students into homeroom classes.

The Zach teachers are some of the most high-quality educators in the state. The Principal does not process parent requests for teacher changes, instead this is done through our grade level teams. It's important that children experience situations in safe environments where they meet new people and learn how to socially interact with people similar and different from them. In the event you feel there is absolutely no way your child can happily function in a particular homeroom after they have experienced the first week of school, then you can contact the teacher directly between Sept 1st-3rd. The teacher will then review the request with their grade level team and make a decision by Sept 4. In the event a change is made, your child would start in their new homeroom class on Sept 8th. No changes to classes are made after this time frame.

FAMILY ORIENTATION

We will host a more traditional family orientation prior to returning to school in Phase 3. At that time, families may be able to come into the building for tours and classroom visits, in small groups. No date is set yet.

Back to School Nights 8/19 & 8/20
