COVID-19: Child/Staff Feels/Appears Unwell after Arriving at School

STOP If the person has any of the following symptoms, immediately call 911, and **DO NOT** place a mask on the person.
Difficulty breathing, chest pain, new confusion, difficulty concentrating, bluish lips or face.

1. If it is safe to do so, have the ill student/staff put on a mask if not already wearing one.
2. Arrange for ill person to go home. For ill students, inform parents and have student picked up early.
3. Assist the student to an area that is separate from others, but within adult line of sight.
4. Students/staff sent home should contact a healthcare provider and ask for COVID-19 PCR testing.
5. Refer to the [COVID-19 Return to School/Work guidance](#) to determine when it is appropriate to return to school.

1. Follow routine illness care
2. Return to class if appropriate. Alert teacher to monitor the student with heightened awareness.
3. Record visit in the usual manner.

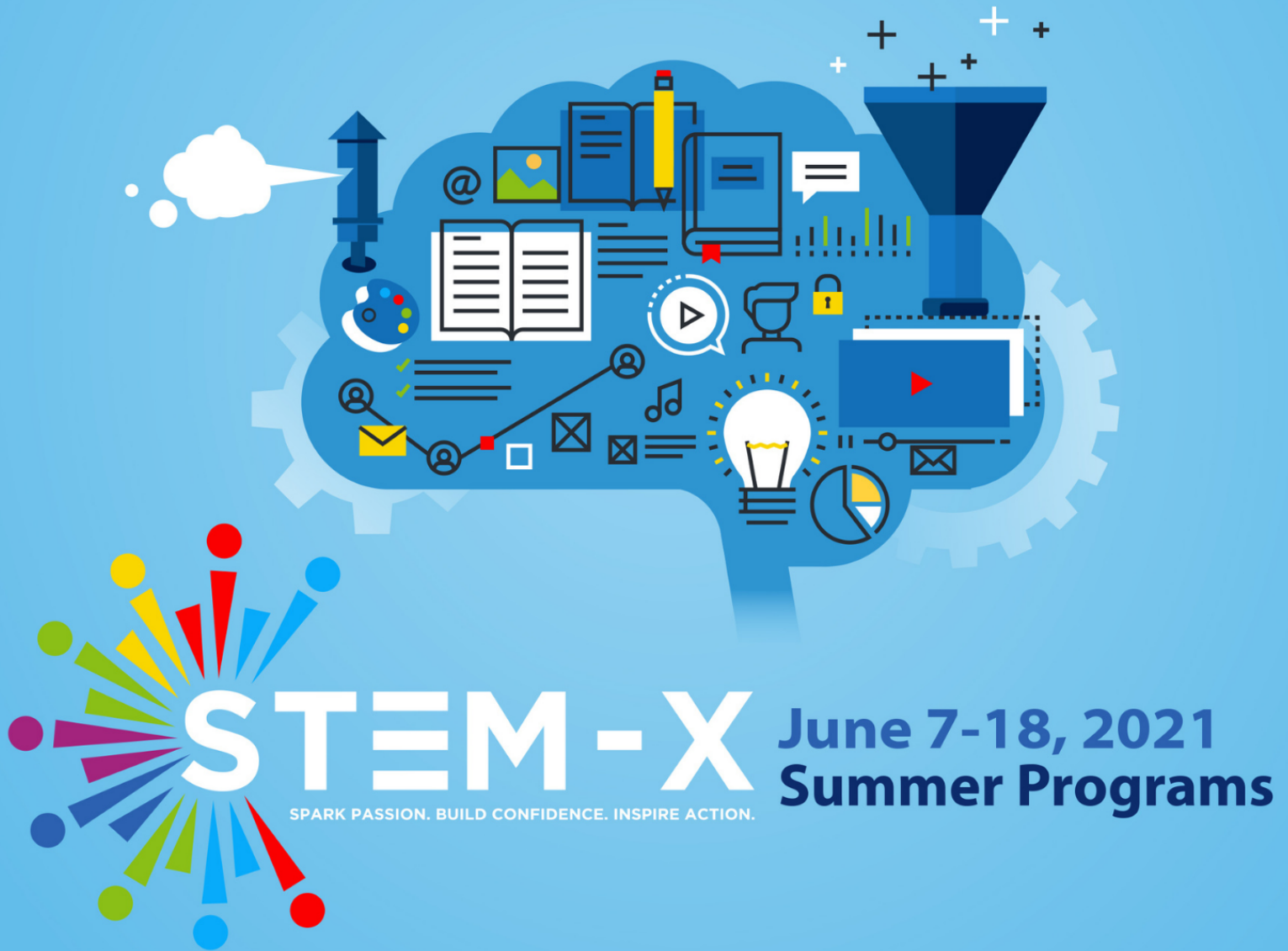


CAPS 4 CASH Earn \$25!
