P\$D Pilot Program at Zach

Zach is one of five schools that will pilot Poudre School District's biased incident reporting tool. One of PSD's goals with this new system is to give students and their family members a place where they may report specific issues they may experience or witness in our school community. With this information, in collaboration with the district's Language, Culture and Equity team, our Zach team will respond to ensure that our school is a safe and welcoming space for all learners. 4th and 5th graders will learn about this pilot and incident/bias types during SEL class starting May 10th.

Incident types are things like: Damage, destruction of property or vandalism; threats; phone/email/text message/written harassment; intimidation; verbal harassment; discrimination; physical harassment; social media harassment; and microaggressions. Bias type are things like: Immigration or citizenship; disability; sexual orientation; gender expression; gender identity; religion; sex; race; national origin; and more.

How to report online:

The report is sent to members of the district's Language, Culture and Equity Department, who will collaborate with our team at Zach. We will review the report and determine the appropriate response. The pilot program will run through the end of the school year. During the pilot and once it is completed, the district will evaluate what went well and could be improved. The goal is to make the tool available to a broader PSD audience in the 2021-22 school year.
