

## Health Office News

### Nonmedical Exemption

**For the 2021-2022 school year:**

Beginning in the 2021-2022 school year (7/1/2021), the process of submitting a nonmedical exemption will change. There will be **two** ways to submit a nonmedical exemption.

**Be sure to check with your student's school, childcare, or college/university to find out if they need a printed copy of the Certificate of nonmedical exemption or if you submit to CIIS, the school is able to access the Certificate of nonmedical exemption from CIIS.**

- Submit the Certificate of nonmedical exemption WITH a signature from an immunizing provider who is a medical doctor, Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine, advanced practice nurse or delegated physician's assistant **OR**
- Submit the Certificate of nonmedical exemption received upon the completion of CDPHE's Online Immunization Education Module.
- Parents of students in preschool or childcare must submit nonmedical exemptions at 2, 4, 6, 12 and 18 months of age. These exemptions expire when the next vaccines are due or when the child enrolls in kindergarten.
- Parents of students in grades K-12 claiming a nonmedical exemption must submit one annually. **Nonmedical exemptions expire June 30th each year.** If you submit a Certificate of nonmedical exemption on or before June 30th, it will not be valid for the upcoming school year unless you submit the exemption during early registration.

### Medication pickup

All medication must be picked up by 11:30 am on Wednesday May 28th, 2021. This is the last day of school and it is a half day for students. You can pick up medications anytime at your convenience before the last day. If your student needs daily medications and you would like to pick up before the last day of school, the needed number of pills can be counted out and kept in the original RX container here at school.

### Medication Disposal

Our school nurse will follow state guidelines and dispose of all medications not picked up by 11:30 am on the last day of school. Medications cannot be kept in the health office over the summer. Thank you for your understanding.

### Tdap Vaccine Requirement 2021-2022 School Year

#### All 6th through 12th graders are required to have had a Tdap booster

- Most secondary students have had this booster, and it is recorded on their school record.
- Students entering 6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade may still need the vaccine.
- The “p” (pertussis) has been added to the standard Td booster in order to protect teens against whooping cough.

#### Prior to the first day of school, a copy of the immunization record from the doctor’s office must be provided to the school.

- If they have already received the booster, you may give this record to their current school before school is out.
- vaccines are recommended for Hepatitis A, Influenza, Meningococcal disease, and Human papillomavirus (HPV), but are not required.

Colorado law ([Board of Health rule 6 CCR 1009-2](#)) requires all students attending Colorado schools and licensed child cares to be vaccinated against certain diseases, unless an exemption is filed.

#### Exceptions:

Beginning in the 2021-2022 school year, the process of filing a nonmedical exemption will change. There will be two ways to file a nonmedical exemption. **Be sure to check with your student’s school or child care to find out if it needs a copy of the certificate of exemption.**

- File the certificate of nonmedical exemption WITH a signature from an immunizing provider OR
- File the certificate of nonmedical exemption received upon the completion of our online education module.
  - **The Immunization Education Module will be available mid-January 2021.**
- Parents of students in grades K-12 claiming a nonmedical exemption must file one annually. **Nonmedical exemptions expire June 30 each year.** If you submit a nonmedical exemption on or before June 30, it will not be valid for the upcoming school year unless you signed the exemption during early registration.

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## PSD Summer Music Program

The Poudre School District is proud to offer an intensive summer music program for the band and orchestra students in PSD. For students just starting their experience, this program is the first step to success – with guidance on everything from opening the case and assembling the instrument to their first performance. For students who already play a band or orchestra instrument, the summer session allows students to continue to refine their technique and continue to bond with their friends and teachers over the summer.

It is our sincere hope that we will be able to offer summer music classes during the summer of 2021. Our first priority will be to the safety of the students and staff, so we are asking people to save these dates with the understanding that if Poudre School District or the Larimer Health Department determine it in the students' best interest to delay or cancel the program. We will make the adjustments and inform parents and students as quickly as we can. As regulations shift, please know, that all requirements regarding numbers of students, distancing and masks will be followed.

Summer Beginning Music (for any band or orchestra student who will be starting an instrument in 2021-2022); Monday-Friday, July 19-August 6

Classes are offered in the mornings (beginning classes are 50 minutes; intermediate and advanced classes are 80 minutes) at numerous sites around Fort Collins and Wellington.
